Jorge Garbajosa was elected as FIBA Europe President in May 2023.

In his previous role, he served as the President of the Spanish Basketball Federation from 2016 to 2023.

Since 2019, he has also been a member of the FIBA Europe Executive Committee, a co-opted member of the FIBA Central Board and chair of the FIBA Competitions Commission.

As a player, Garbajosa had an impressive international career with the Spanish national team, winning the FIBA Basketball World Cup in 2006 and lifting the FIBA EuroBasket trophy in 2009.

His list of accomplishments also includes a silver medal at the Olympic Basketball Tournament in 2008 and three more FIBA EuroBasket podium finishes – second place in 2003 and 2007 and third place in 2001.

During his illustrious professional career, Garbajosa represented a number of top European clubs, winning the Spanish and Italian League Cup titles, and also played in the NBA.

He will serve as FIBA Vice President for the 2023-2027 term.

Anibal Aurelio Manave was re-elected as President of FIBA Africa following the Region's General Assembly in June 2023.

Manave, a native of Mozambique, will serve another four-year term until 2027.

The 58-year-old former player, coach and commissioner, took over from Hamane Niang, who was elected as FIBA President in August in Beijing, China.

As well as being a member of FIBA Central Board, Manave, a civil engineer by profession, has been named President of the Board for the newly-launched Basketball Africa League, a competition to be organized by the National Basketball Association (NBA) in partnership with FIBA.

Manave has been involved in basketball activities both at national and continental level for over three decades, a dedication that saw him win eight national titles as a player, as well as an African Cup title in 1985 with Clube Desportivo Maxaquene of Mozambique.

In one of his latest key roles within FIBA Africa hierarchy, Manave served as a Chairman of FIBA Africa Zone 6 from 2008 to 2019.

Throughout his basketball administrative career, Manave served as President of Mozambique Basketball Federation from 1999 to 2007.

Aside from his FIBA Africa President role, Manave currently serves as President of Mozambique Olympic Committee.

He will serve as FIBA Vice President for the 2023-2027 term.

Fabian Borro was elected as FIBA Americas President in May 2023.

He has held important positions in the world of Argentine basketball for many years and has extensive experience within FIBA.

Borro became president of the Argentine Basketball Confederation (CAB) in December 2019. He had the support and backing of 14 Federations.

Before being elected president of CAB, he was President of the Obras Sanitarias Club (Buenos Aires), the Metropolitan Basketball Federation (Febamba), and the Association of Clubs (AdC), the entity that organizes the National League (first division of the Argentine basketball league), the Argentine League (second division) and the Women's League. In addition, he served as director of logistics support for AySA, a company in charge of providing water and sewage services for the City of Buenos Aires, Argentina.

Dr. K Govindaraj was elected FIBA Asia President in May 2023, becoming the first Indian to hold the position. The 64-year-old, who is also the president of the Karnataka Olympic Association (KOA), succeeded Sheikh Saud Ali Al Thani, who was elected FIBA President in August 2023 in Manila, Philippines.

As well as being a member of FIBA Central Board for the 2019-2023 cycle, FIBA Asia Youth Basketball Committee Chariman and President of South Asian Basketball Association (SABA), Dr. Govindaraj served as the President of Basketball Federation of India (BFI) from 2015 until 2023. He also served as the vice-president of the BFI between 2007 and 2015.

As an administrator, Dr. Govindaraj contributed to the growth of basketball in India and during his presidency, India hosted numerous Asian events, most notably the successful hosting of two consecutive editions of the FIBA Women's Asia Cup (2017 and 2019).

The first-ever National Basketball League (INBL 5x5) was also established during his tenure.
