FIBA's flagship men's competition, the FIBA Basketball World Cup, was first played in 1950 in Argentina. This will be the 19th edition of international basketball's premier competition.

The world's best players from basketball's powerhouse nations across Africa, Americas, Asia & Oceania and Europe will trade blows over 92 games in Manila's

Philippine Arena, Araneta Coliseum and Mall of Asia Arena in the Philippines, the Okinawa Arena in Japan and Indonesia Arena in Jakarta from Friday, 25 August to Sunday,10 September 2023.

While this is the first time FIBA Basketball World Cup games will be played in Indonesia, the Philippines and Japan have staged the competition before. The Philippines hosted the FIBA Basketball World Cup 1978 In Manila, and Japan organized the spectacular tournament in 2006 in Hamamatsu, Hiroshima, Sapporo, Sendai and Saitama.

## PRACTICE SESSIONS MEDIA RULES

#### ALL OFFICIAL TEAM PRACTICES ARE CLOSED TO THE MEDIA AND THE PUBLIC.

The last 5 minutes of the practice are open to the media for photo and video opportunities. The 10 minutes after every practice session are considered media minutes, where the team leaving practice should be available to the media for interviews which must be conducted in the Mixed Zone area.

For Game Day - 1 the head coach and a selected player are excused from the media minutes as they will be attending the pre-event press conference.

The Team Media Officer has the responsibility to coordinate pending media requests and let the media in for the 5 minutes of photo/video opportunity at the end of the practice sessions. FIBA Media Operations staff and/or LOC Media Operations Staff will be present during practice sessions and ready to assist with anything regarding the media.

If a team chooses to keep their practice sessions open to the media longer than the last 5 minutes, media will be informed via the Accredited Media WhatsApp Group.

# Kindly note the Media Access to the Team Hotels is prohibited.

## MEDIA WORKING ROOM ACCESS

The media working room in the competition venues will be open every day as of Wednesday 23 August.

- Opening time: beginning of first practice session according to the practice schedule (that will be shared in the Media WhatsApp Group Chats)
- · Closing time:
- Game Day: 2h after the end of the last game in the venue
- Rest day 4 September: closing 1h after the end of the last practice in the venue

#### ACCESS TO MEDIA TRIBUNE AND PHOTOGRAPHERS POSITIONS

Access to the Media Tribune and Photographers positions will be possible 1.5h before the beginning of each game.

During practice sessions, access to these two areas will not be granted (except for the last 5 minutes of each session).

Interviews during the post-practice media availability minutes will have to be conducted in the Flash interview area and/or Mixed zone.

#### **DRESS CODE FOR MEDIA**

The World Cup is a major sporting event and all media areas must be considered a professional environment for the accredited media. As such, we kindly request all media to dress accordingly.

## ACCREDITED MEDIA TRANSPORTATION

Dedicated Accredited Media Shuttles are provided by the Local Organising Committee from the Official Media Hotel(s) to the Main Competition Venue(s), and the daily schedule is available at the Media Hotel Info Desk. Free access to the dedicated shuttle buses is granted based on the event media accreditation badge.

For the Philippines, dedicated accredited media shuttles may be organized in between the competition venues (Araneta Coliseum – Mall of Asia) upon request, the day before until 6 PM at the Media Hotel Info Desk, and it's subject to shuttles buses availability.

## PHOTO BRIEF INFORMATION FOR ACCREDITED PHOTOGRAPHERS

In each venue on Game Day 1 (August 25) there will be an Accredited Photographers Briefing led by the Official FIBA Photographers and with the Participation of the FIBA Media Operations Manager and the Local Organising Committee Media Operations Venue Lead. # INTERNATIONAL MEDIA KIT

#### MEDIA LOGO USAGE GUIDELINES

#### **USAGE PRINCIPLES**

FIBA provides high quality digital versions of the official logo of the competition to the media free of charge. Media are welcome to use it **for legitimate non-commercial editorial and informational purposes**, provided that such practice does not create any link between the World Cup and any other entities.

FIBA encourages media providing original editorial coverage of the FIBA Basketball World Cup 2023 to use the Official Logo in connection with their editorial coverage. Nevertheless, the official logo may not be used for any advertising or promotional purposes, including on any products for commercial purposes, as for example in any competition or other type of contest.

The terms of use specified here cover all forms of media/platforms, from print to digital sources, including all sorts of TV, web and mobile channels.

Media may use the official logo in editorial coverage of the Event in compliance as follows:

- The official logo may be used for the purpose of identifying or illustrating articles about or news coverage of the World Cup.
- The official logo must not be used as an essential part of the layout or as an element of the branding in the publication.
- No promotional/advertising use is allowed, in any case.

The official logo can be downloaded <u>here</u> and used following the below guidance:

#### **CLEAR SPACE**

A clear space equivalent to the height of the FIBA hoop should be maintained around the vertical and the horizontal lock-ups.

On the wordmark the clear space is equivalent to the height of the "B" letter.

No text, graphics or symbols should be placed within this space



#### **COLOR VERSIONS**

The logo is provided in full or flat colours as well animated. Negative versions are to be used on dark or busy backgrounds, while positive version in light backgrounds. and there is a special version to be used on red backgrounds. One colour version is also provided in case needed













#### **USE ON COLOR BACKGROUNDS**

Ton grayscale or coloured backgrounds, when the brightness of the background is below 30%, the positive version of the logo should be used. If above 30%, the negative version of the logo should be applied. This is to ensure legibility, please follow accordingly.







COLOURED BACKGROUN

#### **UNACCAPTABLE USAGE**

Do not rearrange components of the lock-ups;

Do not recolour the artwork;

Do not rotate components of the lock-ups;

Do not place the wrong version of the artwork on a non-contrasting background;

Do not distort the artwork;

Do not change the size arrangements of the elements;

Do not remove components of the lock-ups;

Do not change the font or the font colour

The Referees will be available to talk online about their preparation and personal experience at the event, but will not comment or answer questions on specific teams or games they may officiate.







#### **TIME ZONE**

Manila is using the Philippine Standard Time, it's the official time zone used in the country and it has an offset of UTC/GMT +08:00 for standard time.

#### LANGUAGE

The official languages of the Philippines are Filipino and English, but around 182 native languages are spoken across the nation.

#### **CURRENCY**

The official currency of the Philippines is the Philippine Peso (PHP).

#### **ELECTRICITY**

The Philippines operated on a 220V voltage and 60Hz and all three plug types are used across the country. Plug type A has two flat parallel pins, type B has two flat parallel pins and a grounding pin and type C has two round pins. As so, traveling with a plug adapted is strongly recommended.

#### **EMERGENCY SERVICES**

The general emergency number in the Philippines is 911 and it can be used for police, fire or ambulance.



#### **DAYLIGHT HOURS**

The average length of the day in August in Manila is 12h and 36min, and 12h and 13 min in September.

On the last day of August, sunrise is at 5:43 am and sunset is at 6:09 pm PST, with an average sunshine of 8.4 hours in August and September.

#### **MANILA WEATHER**

The rainy season in the Philippines is starting from June to November. The average temperature in Manila for August-September is 30.5°C or 86.9°F and these months are the most humid, with an average relative humidity of 81%.

# WIRELESS DEVICES & FREQUENCY MANAGEMENT

#### FOR ALL STAKEHOLDERS

1. Prohibition of using wireless devices

In principle, devices which emit radio waves are prohibited to be used or bring into Okinawa Arena excluding devices listed on 2.

#### **Examples of prohibited devices**

Walkie-talkie, Wireless Microphone / Ear Monitor (IEM), Wireless Camera Camera Telemetry systems, Wireless LAN and other data transmission, Control and data transmission for digital still cameras etc.

- 2. Wireless devices permitted to use in the Arena
  The following wireless devices are permitted to use in Okinawa Arena.
  - A. Mobile phone services provided by Japanese telecommunications carriers.
  - Mobile phones complying with the international technical standard and connected to the network through international roaming or SIM cards provided by Japanese telecommunication carriers, and bearing the "Giteki" mark either on the device or in the "Legal/Certificates" portion of the device's menu.
  - C. Portable Wi-Fi complying with the international technical standard and connected to the network through international roaming or SIM cards provided by Japanese telecommunication carriers. However, an approval from FIBA and the LOC is required to bring portable Wi-Fi to some specific areas such as the courtside, broadcasting areas and media centre.

#### FOR RIGHTS-HOLDERS

- D. Devices provided by FIBA's domestic equipment supplier. Please note that some devices such as wireless cameras require 4 months' lead time to receive a licence.
- E. Broadcast devices procured within Japan and licenced to a Japanese Broadcaster can only be used if registered with FIBA(LOC) and NEP's frequency coordinator (to prevent interference with Host Broadcast facilities).

There is a U.S. military base located next to the arena. Using wired connections is recommended, whenever possible, as there could be interferences with radio waves emitted from the base.

#### 3. Miscellaneous

Satellite communication

In case of having no other means of communication other than via satellite, please use the services that are provided by companies already operating satellite telecommunication businesses in Japan, both for domestic and international communications.

In such cases, terms for the use of satellites and frequency bands shall be as close as possible to the ones currently provided by the companies as their regular services.





## **EQUIPMENT FREQUENCY REGISTRATION**

1. Equipment Entry Permit Recommendation

Entry Permit Recommendation of transceiver equipment issued by MCIT is required for clearance process in Custom.

2. Temporary Radio Station License

Temporary Radio Station License is required for every transceiver equipment.

MCIT allocates radio frequency used for every transceiver in order to prevent harmful interference from and to other existing transceivers.

The applicant is obliged to use given radio frequency with technical parameter such as transmit power, bandwidth and area of operation as specified in the license.
