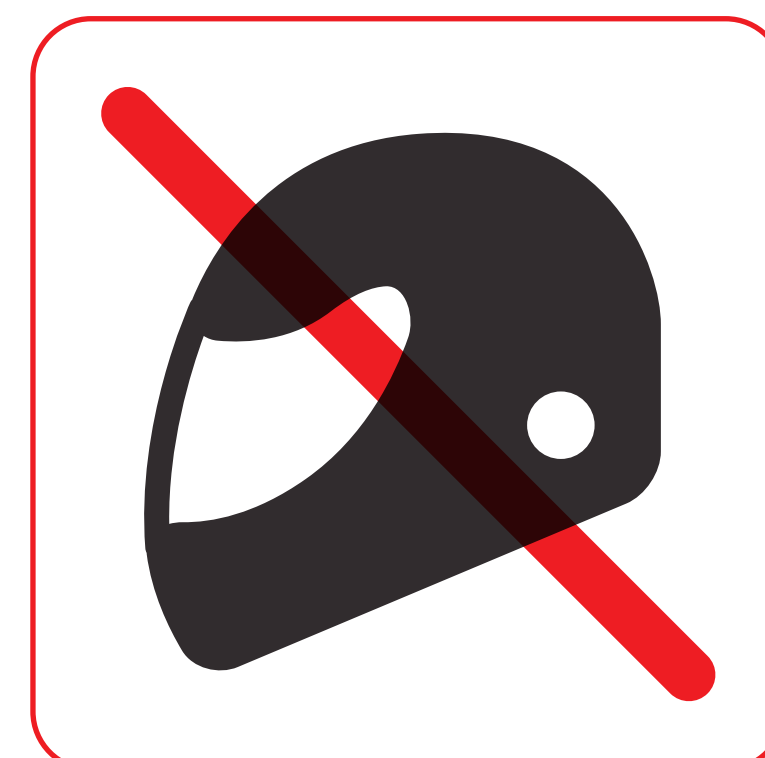
Liquids, aerosols and gels

 (excluding drinks for babies/
 small children) Flasks, thermos
Glass bottles



Working tools



Noisemakers such as
hunting horns, air horns,
klaxons, megaphones,
vuvuzelas and whistles



Motorcycle and other
full-face helmets



Baby carriage



Bags exceeding the maximum
 size of **DIN A4** (21.0 x 29.7 cm)



Walkie-talkies, phone
jammers and radio scanners
Personal/private wireless
access points and 3G hubs
 (smart devices such as Android
 phones, iPhone and tablets are
 permitted inside venues, but
 must not be used as wireless
 access points to connect
 multiple devices)
Laser pointers and strobe lights



Items too large to be
electronically screened



Bicycles, folding bikes,
roller-skates and skateboards



Pets or animals (excluding
 service animals with prior
 agreement with event organizers)



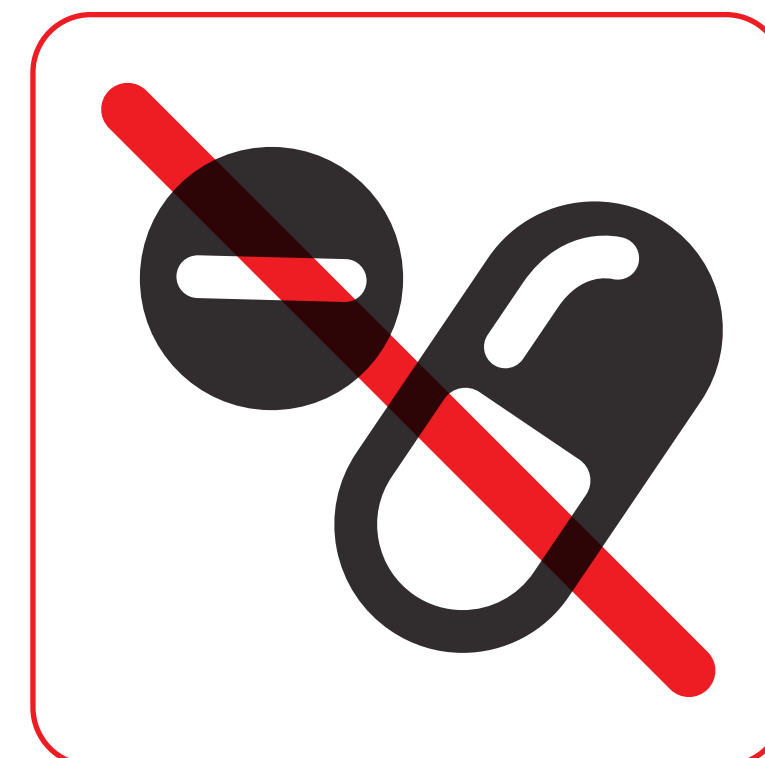
All types of knives and
bladed items, including pocket
 knives and knives carried as part
 of cultural dress
Offensive weapons or
implements such as bayonets,
 flick knives, extendable batons,
 sharpened combs, modified
 belt buckles and loose blades
 modified into weapons
Items that resemble
prohibited items such
 as replica guns or hoax
 explosive devices
Personal protection sprays
 such as CS or pepper sprays
Firearms and ammunition
 (including replicas, component
 parts or any device suspected
 to be a firearm)



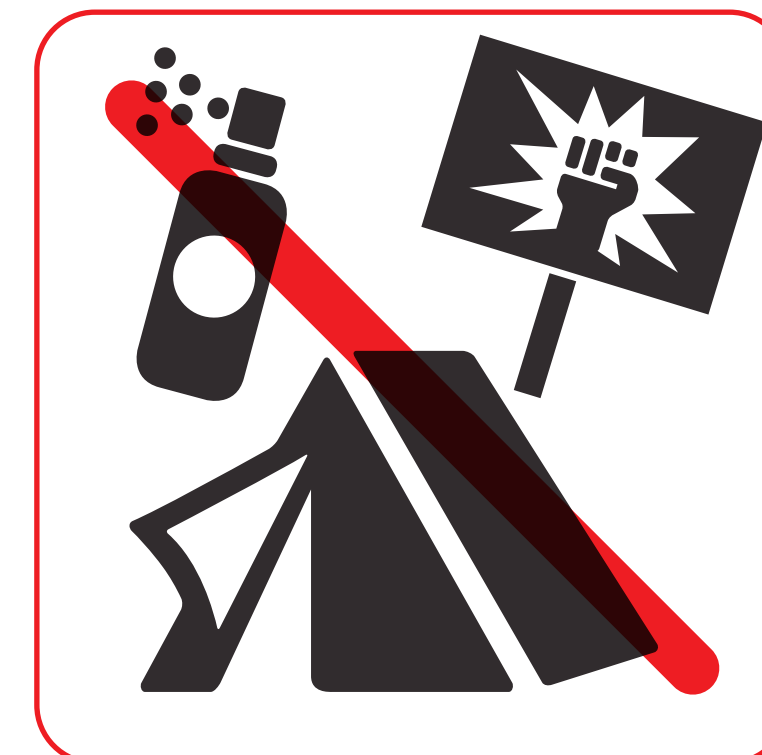
Explosives, flares and
smoke canisters
Any kind of flammable/
explosive substances, liquids
 or gases or other flammable
 substances including but not
 limited to fireworks



Poles (i.e. flag poles) of
 hard material and/or longer
 than 1 meter



Controlled drugs, including
 substances which look like
 controlled drugs



Tents, placards, spray paint
 or any other item which could
 be used to demonstrate within
 the venue or sabotage property



Paper rolls (including
 toilet paper, cash register
 rolls, confetti)



Balls, rackets, frisbees or
 similar objects or projectiles



All other objects and
substances that might
 endanger security, public health,
 public order and/or reputation of
 FIBA, Host and venue



Video cameras, regardless of size,
 model, range and selfie sticks
Any telephoto lens above
150mm aperture including
tripods and monopods.
 You cannot use photographic
 or broadcast equipment for
 commercial purposes unless you
 hold media accreditation



All flags except the official
flags of the countries of
teams (and respective
countries) participating in
the Event



Hazardous and toxic
materials



Oversized hats



No food - Except specialized
food for babies.

The items above are not allowed in the venues of
FIBA competition.
Persons carrying any of the items above will not be
allowed into the venues and may be transferred to
the local law enforcement representatives.

Large "golf-style" umbrellas
