



FIBA-LICENSED AGENTS CERTIFICATION PROCESS

Dear candidate,

On 1 September 2006, the amended FIBA Internal Regulations (“Regulations”) came into force including the regulations governing FIBA-Licensed Agents (“Agents”) contained in:

BOOK 3 - Chapter 9 - Articles 291 to 324 (referred to as 3-292 to 3-325)
(Pages 50-55)

These regulations govern the activities of Agents who bring about or assist in the International Transfers of Players. The aim of these Regulations is to make sure that a high standard of quality and transparency is guaranteed for the activities of Agents and International Transfers in the FIBA family.

In order to implement these Regulations, a “Certification Process” has been put in place according to which:

1. Any individual wishing to act as an agent in the international world of basketball and within the FIBA family must be licensed by FIBA with a so-called Agents licence.
2. The requirements for the granting of the Agents licence by FIBA are laid down in [Articles 3-300 to 3-312](#) of the Regulations.

Please find hereafter the practical information for any candidate wishing to be a FIBA-Licensed Agent.

Application Form (online registration)

Candidate shall file an application with FIBA on the standard application form according to [Article 3-300](#) of the Regulations.

Test (in English only !)

Since 2007 tests sessions are held twice a year at the FIBA Headquarter (Mies, Switzerland). Complimentary sessions are also organised within both the FIBA Americas & the FIBA Asia/Oceania zones, according to the demand.

Costs

The administrative cost for the interview and the test is **CHF 250.00** (Swiss Francs) per candidate.

Travel & Accommodation

Candidates are responsible for arranging their own transportation and accommodation at their expense.

BAT

FIBA provides clubs, players and agents with a new mechanism for the resolution of disputes through arbitration. Therefore, we strongly recommend that study carefully the FIBA Internal Regulations – **Articles 3-325 to 3-340** - regarding the Basketball Arbitral Tribunal - BAT (formerly known as FAT) available on the FIBA website.

Preparation for the test

The test will consist in a multiple choices questionnaire which is based on the following extracts of the FIBA Internal Regulations governing:

- Eligibility & National Status of Players : **Articles 3-1** to **3-51**
- International Transfer of Players : **Articles 3-52** to **3-96**
- Registration of Players : **Articles 3-144** to **3-145**
- Players' Agents : **Articles 3-291** to **3-324**
